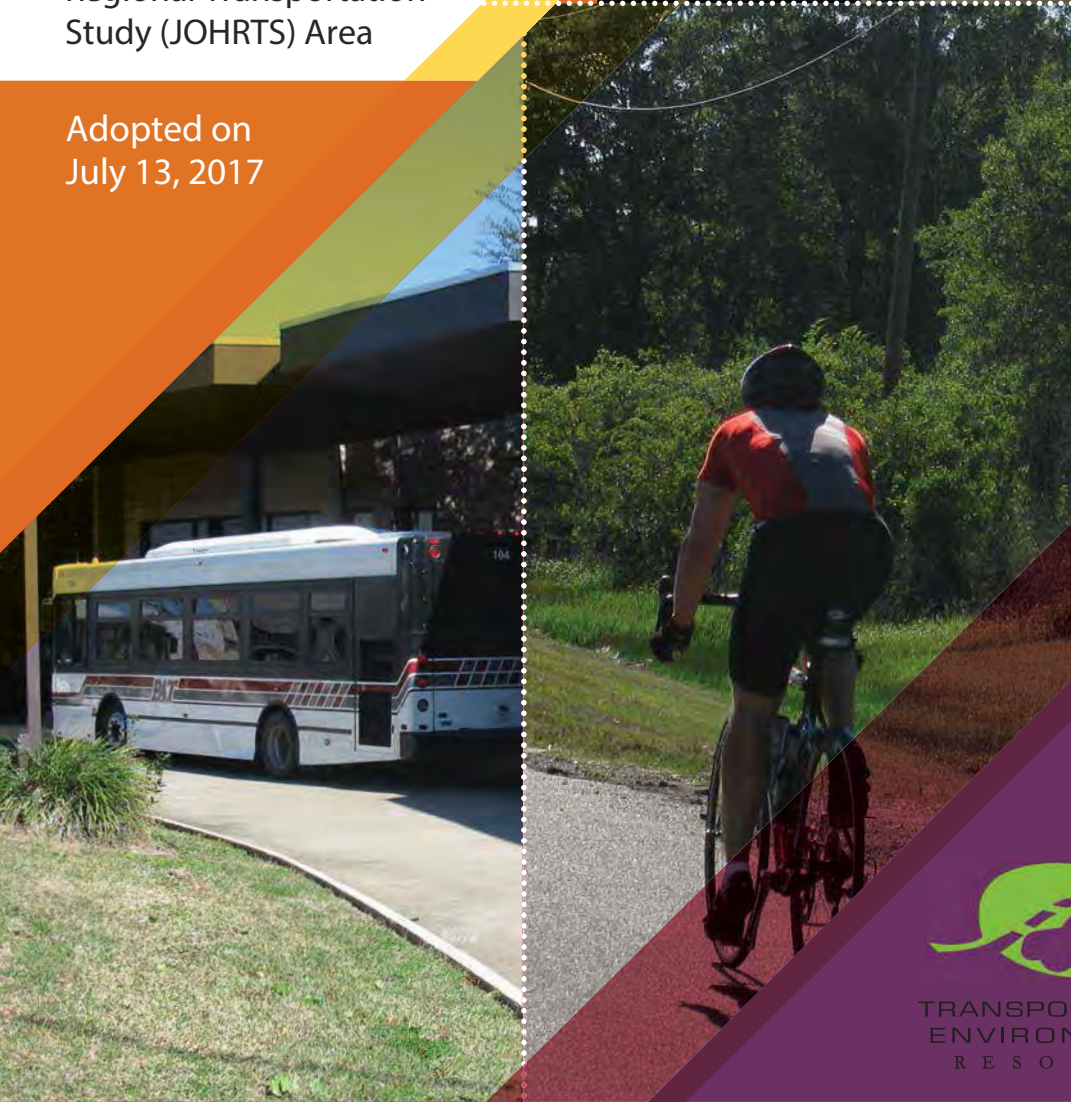



- WHEREAS, the JOHRTS Transportation Planning Committee approved the adoption of the JOHRTS 2017-2020 TIP, Amendment #3.



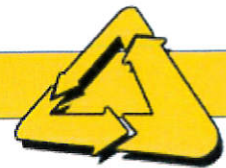
